EXECUTIVE ORDER #151

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Lance Corporal Anthony T. DuBeau of the United States Marine Corps, Who Lost His Life While Serving His Country

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2015, Lance Cpl. Anthony T. DuBeau of Kenosha, Wisconsin, a member of the Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron at the Marine Corps Air Station in Yuma, Arizona, died in a tragic crash at the Marine Corps Air Station; and

WHEREAS, Lance Cpl. Anthony T. DuBeau faithfully served the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States, earning the recognition of receiving the National Defense Service Medal and the Global War on Terrorism Medal; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Lance Cpl. Anthony T. DuBeau; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Lance Cpl. Anthony T. DuBeau on Saturday, March 21, 2015;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State and by federal law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, March 21, 2015**, and ending at sunset on that date.
