EXECUTIVE ORDER #165

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Firefighter Dale J. Wege of the Pine Lake Volunteer Fire Department

WHEREAS, on Monday, June 1, 2015, Dale J. Wege, a firefighter with the Pine Lake Volunteer Fire Department in Rhinelander, Wisconsin, died within twenty-four hours of responding to an emergency medical call; and

WHEREAS, Dale J. Wege served as a firefighter for well over two decades, rising to the rank of Deputy Chief in the Rhinelander Fire Department and continuing to serve after retirement by volunteering with the Pine Lake Volunteer Fire Department; and


WHEREAS, Dale J. Wege had also served the people of the United States and the people of the State of Wisconsin as a member of the United States Navy; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Dale J. Wege in Rhinelander, Wisconsin, on Saturday, June 13, 2015;

NOW THEREFORE, I, **SCOTT WALKER**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, June 13, 2015**, and ending at sunset on that date.
