EXECUTIVE ORDER #201

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff Honoring Fallen Dallas Law Enforcement Officers.

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2016, the city of Dallas was the victim of a deliberate and devastating attack against law enforcement; and

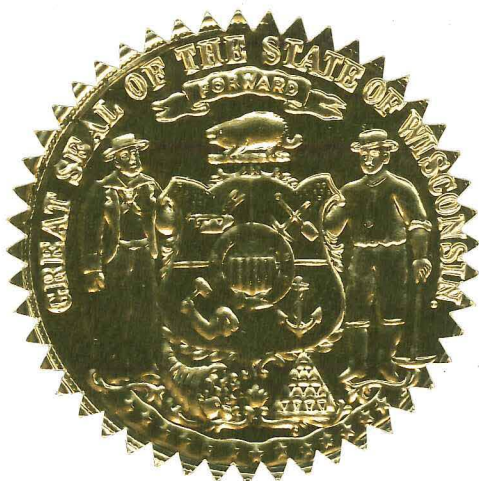
WHEREAS, five officers were slain and an additional seven officers were wounded during an ambush on Dallas law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, this violent and appalling attack resulted in the largest amount of casualties inflicted on law enforcement in the United States since the attacks on September 11, 2001; and


WHEREAS, a native of Fox Lake, Wisconsin, was one of the brave officers who was wounded in this tragedy; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of Wisconsin mourn the death of the fallen officers who put their lives and safety at risk to keep their communities safe;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, **beginning immediately and ending at sunset on Tuesday, July 12, 2016.**


