EXECUTIVE ORDER #220

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Senator Rick Gudex of the 18th Senate District

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2016, Senator Rick Gudex passed away unexpectedly at the age of 48; and

WHEREAS, Senator Rick Gudex served in the Wisconsin State Senate since his election to represent the people of the 18th Senate District in 2012; and

WHEREAS, prior to his election in 2012, Senator Rick Gudex served as the Mayor of Mayville, and also served on the Eden Village Board and the Fond du Lac City Council; and

WHEREAS, as a member of the Senate, Senator Rick Gudex served as Senate President Pro Tempore; Chairman of the Economic Development and Commerce Committee; Chairman of the Economic Development and Local Government Committee; Vice Chairman of the Workforce Development, Public Works and Military Affairs Committee; and Vice Chairman of the Government Operations, Public Works, and Telecommunications Committee; and

WHEREAS, Senator Rick Gudex was a dedicated public servant, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his passing; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Senator Rick Gudex on Monday, October 17, 2016;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, beginning at sunrise on **Monday, October 17, 2016**, and ending at sunset on that date.
