MADISON, Wis. — Verizon Public Safety Offerings on State Wireless Contract

The State of Wisconsin (the State) has signed a contract amendment with Verizon that will allow state, local and tribal public safety agencies to subscribe to the Verizon public safety services in the state.

The State's wireless services contract 505ENT-M17-WIRELESSPH-01, Amendment 3, provides Mobile Broadband Priority and Preemption services for National Security, Public Safety, Emergency Preparedness, and First Responders. Through this amendment, authorized public safety agencies can immediately begin utilizing the State of Wisconsin pricing and services.

This service plan is available to Verizon's National Security, Public Safety, Emergency Preparedness, First Responders customers who are eligible to use this Contract only as defined by the following NAICS (formerly SIC) Codes:
