





Communications Unit Standard Operating Guidelines Position Task Book Evaluator and Final Evaluator Endorsement Application Packet

Purpose

The Wisconsin Communications Unit Standard Operating Guidelines (SOG) establishes the process for requesting recognition for position-specific roles within the Incident Command System (ICS) organization, specifically to Communications Unit personnel within the State of Wisconsin.

The SOG contains statements of best practices which, in many cases, strive to exceed and improve upon prevailing standard practices, standards, and qualifications. The position task book evaluator endorsement requirement is an example of Wisconsin's desire to improve upon existing practices to ensure the highest standards for the various communications unit training and recognition programs.

The purpose of the evaluator and final evaluator endorsement is to ensure that individuals serving in these two positions are qualified and proficient in the position being evaluated or are qualified in a position that supervises that position within the Incident Command System (ICS) Communications Unit organization.

Requirements

Applications for **Evaluator** Endorsement will be assessed on criteria including, but not limited to the following:

- Completion of the most current versions of online ICS courses 100, 200, 700, and 800 as listed in the FEMA training catalog
- Documented body of work that demonstrates hands on experience in communications that has allowed for the sign-off of the Position Task Book (PTB) for either COML or COMT
- Existing position-specific recognition by the Land Mobile Radio Subcommittee
- Continued engagement/participation in communications post-recognition
- Demonstrated understanding of the requirements/procedure for signing off PTBs
- Demonstrated ability to function independently
- Demonstrated technical skills
- Demonstrated ability in interpersonal communication
- Demonstrates the ability to objectively and professionally evaluate others
 - Candidate may be asked to perform an evaluation under the observation of a final evaluator at the discretion of the COMU WG

Applications for **Final Evaluator** Endorsement will be assessed on criteria including, but not limited to the following:

- Must have attained Evaluator recognition
- Must be a state-recognized COML and COMT
- Demonstrated exceptional interpersonal communication skills
- Actively engaged as a mentor to others
- Have been observed by a SME while mentoring others
- Documented high quality body of work
- Recommendations by COMM peers
- Submitted letter of interest to the COMU WG
- An in-person evaluation meeting with the COMU WG may be required
