About the Symposium

The 2010 Wisconsin Interoperability Symposium will bring together public safety stakeholders from across the state to discuss and review proposed activities of the Wisconsin Interoperability Council (IC) and the WISCOM Statewide System Management Group (SSMG).

The event is being held in conjunction with the regular recurring meetings of the groups and will offer stakeholders an opportunity to provide input on a revised strategic plan for improving Wisconsin's public safety radio communications strategies.

The revised plan will influence future funding decisions related to communications interoperability activities. The current State Communication Interoperability Plan (SCIP) can be viewed at the Wisconsin Interoperability Initiative website at www.Interop.wi.gov.

Also included:

- ⊕ Briefing and Q&A on WISCOM—a shared radio system that first responders in communities across the state will use to

communicate during a major disaster or large scale event.

- ⊕ Governance of the Wisconsin Interoperability Initiative and the WISCOM system.
- ⊕ Selection of at-large members to the WISCOM Statewide System Management Group. Two county-wide and two local delegates will be selected to serve for a two year term.
- ⊕ Inaugural planning session of the Regional SCIP Council Coordinators. Coordinators are responsible for guiding local implementations of the statewide strategic plan.

Who should attend?

Representatives from local law enforcement, fire service, emergency management, emergency medical services, independent 911 PSAP and non-profit emergency services agencies may register up to two delegates.

Each Regional SCIP Council may also register the regional coordinator.
