**SUBJECT: SITUATION REPORT #8 ON SEVERE WEATHER**

OVERVIEW – Latest damage reports as of 5:00 a.m.:

Weather – Flash flood warnings are in effect for Grant, Lafayette, Iowa and Green counties.

Flood warnings continue for rivers in the following counties:

- Fond du Lac County: South Branch Rock River at Waupun
- Kenosha and Lake Counties: Fox River near New Munster
- Jefferson County: Rock River at Jefferson; Rock River at Watertown; Crawfish River at Milford
- Milwaukee County: Root River at Franklin; Oak Creek at South Milwaukee
- Racine County: Fox River at Burlington; Root River at Racine; Root River Canal at Raymond
- Rock County: Rock River at Afton
- Sauk County: Baraboo River near Baraboo
- Waukesha County: Fox River at Waukesha

Grant County – Water partially over roadway in north and southbound lanes of State 151 at Southwest Road. Road is passable; Platteville Fire Dept. is slowing and directing traffic.

Substantial flooding damages are being reported in southern Grant County, including areas south of Lancaster (Potosi, Dickeyville, Platteville, Hazel Green and Cuba City). Numerous secondary town roads have been closed. County Highways B and O are closed.

Several households in the rural Potosi area (British Hollow) have been evacuated by boat. Grant County EOC will be partially open Saturday morning for damage assessment and coordination with municipalities. EOC incoming line: 608-723-7171.
