



EXECUTIVE ORDER #294

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Officer Charles Irvine Jr. of the Milwaukee Police Department

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2018, Officer Charles Irvine Jr. of the Milwaukee Police Department died in the line of duty at the age of 23; and

WHEREAS, Officer Charles Irvine Jr. was a member of the Milwaukee Police Department for four years; and

WHEREAS, Officer Charles Irvine Jr. dedicated his life to protecting and serving the people of Milwaukee and Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Officer Charles Irvine Jr. leaves behind an honorable legacy of service to his community and his state, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, **beginning immediately and ending at sunset on the date of interment.**
