### Many great features are planned for 2006:

- Graphing will be added to journals to make it easier to visualize your health measurements.
- Rx Refill functionality will be upgraded to include name of medication.
- Veteran patients will be able to request key portions of their VA health record (e.g., labs, meds, discharge summaries, patient reminders).
- · Veterans will be able to view appointments and copay balances online
- Veterans will be able to give access to some or all of their health information to others (e.g., doctors, family, veteran advocates)

In the works are other interesting features like secure doctor/patient messaging, moderated discussions on the web, and web-based training/education programs.

#### TRICARE RESERVE SELECT

The TRICARE Reserve Select health plan may be available to you and your family members after your release from active duty. Your active duty must have been in support of a contingency operation on or after 9-11-01, and you will need to agree to stay in the selected reserve for one or more whole years. When applying be sure to: 1. Enter in to your service agreement (complete DD Form 2895), 2. execute the service agreement (signed and submitted) then 3. purchase by sending your first months premium no later than 30 days prior to your TAMP expiring.
